- Click on **“Log in”** to go to the Login page
- Click **“Create new account”** at the bottom of the page and select your username and password (**nb**: you will receive email confirmation of your account, check your spam mailbox if necessary)
- Once you login, click on the Course: **“DevCa - CMIP HTML5/CSS3/JavaScript BootKamp”**. You will then see the Enrolment options. Click on **“Enrol Me”**
